Lake in the Forest Resort Rules and Guidelines

Please use your common sense when at Lake in the Forest; and be respectful of others. These are our Rules and Guidelines and ask that you respect.

- Activities: Any activities will be listed outside the Rec Hall. Some planned activities are: golf lessons, ceramic pouring, ceramic painting, ceramic glazing, jewelry making, glass fusing, glass etching, t-shirt design and painting, glass fusing, etc. All activities with supplies will have a cost which will be due at the beginning of the class.
- **Abusive Language:** Please refrain from abusive and foul language in public parts of the park where other guests can hear you, especially the playground, the dock, the pool and Rec Hall.
- **ATVs:** We do not allow ATV driving in our park. There are wonderful ATV trails close by offered by the Ocala National Forest. Please see office for more info.
- **Bears:** Please read Bear brochure provided at check-in. Garbage left out, dog bowls, dirty grills, coolers will attract Bears. There is a fine for feeding the BEARS.
- Cancellations: There is a 14-day cancellation policy for cabins and sites. Snobirds need to cancel by before the Season (no later than October 1st) for a refund except for nonrefundable deposits.
- **Camp Animal:** VERY IMPORTANT Anyone who would like to feed, visit or help with our camp animals will need to sign animal waiver at registration and will need to be accompanied by a staff member the first time. Please do not bring dogs by our animals.
- **Campfires:** We sell firewood for \$5 a bag which is located behind the rec hall. If office is closed, please slip money under the door with name and site #. Please keep all fires in the fire ring and under 2 feet high. All fires need to be attended and put out before retiring for the evening. No gathering of wood or cutting wood from the park or woods.
- Check in/Check out: Check in time is 2pm. Check out time is 11am. An additional fee will be charged for any guests not checking out on time. Arrangements for a late check out can be made with office, but must be made in advance to your stay. Please be considerate of the guests coming in after you and the time needed to prepare the site for them.
- Children: All children under 12 need to be accompanied at pool, lake or by animals. All children should be back at site or cabin or with adult over 18 at 10pm. Please talk to children about NOT running through others' sites or cabin areas. Damage to and/or Stealing of Camp property or others' property will have the entire group or family asked to leave without a refund.
- **Dogs:** They are welcome to stay. Please keep them on a leash. Dog walk is behind the boat trailers across from the entrance by the canal to the dock. Please do not let them run free or walk them on other sites or on our golf course. Excessive barking dogs should be brought inside

and not left alone. Dogs are not allowed in playground, rec hall or pool area. We do not allow mean or aggressive pets and all pets should be current with their shots. A \$25 cleanup fee will be charged for holes and waste left by your cabin or sites which are not cleaned up when you depart. Please see our specific rules for pets in cabins.

- **Electricity:** All rigs are given a 20-kilowatt allowance per day. Each overage will be charge by the current kg rate. (All Snobirds will be metered per month for all their electricity.)
- **Emergencies:** All medical emergencies should call 911. An EMT response team is close to the park. Other emergencies: Debbie 352-454-9353
- **Fishing Dock:** All children under 12 needs to be accompanied by an adult while at the dock. All non-swimming children should wear life preservers around the water. Please do not feed the gators or drop trash in the lake. When the water level is low, you will need to be more careful when walking and fishing on our dock.
- **Fireworks:** Fireworks are not allowed in the park except sparklers. See office for details.
- Garbage and BEARS: Please drop your garbage in the dumpster frequently to avoid having garbage around. The dumpster door needs to be relocked after every use. Because of occasional unwanted Bear and other animal and rodent traffic, please do not leave garbage on your cabin porch or around your site or cabin. Bears are attracted to open pop cans, wrappers, garbage, dog food bowls (even empty) and food scraps on grill (leave grill top open after grilling). PLEASE REVIEW ALL BEAR INFORMATION. Please also crush boxes before throwing them in dumpster.
- Golf carts: Golf carts are for transportation only. No children driving golf carts unless they have a driver's license. For the safety of the walkers and horseback riders, please keep golf carts on trails or roads and away from wetlands where the golf carts can create holes or dents in the ground. Golf carts need to follow MPH guidelines.
- Guests: All guests need to sign liability form even if they are visiting for the day. All guests are required to pay a guest fee. Each camper and cabin includes 2 adults and 2 children in their rental price and can have up to 4 adults or 6 people for an extra fee. You need to arrange with the office in advance if you are going to exceed the allotted numbers of guests visiting you. Cabins have a max. occupancy at all times of 4 adults or 6 people. If you exceed the allotted amount, you will need to rent more cabins or an additional tent site. SEE OFFICE IN ADVANCE OF EXTRA GUESTS COMING.
- Lot Rental: Snobirds, please make arrangements to have your lot rental paid on its due date. It is your obligation to make sure your payment is either called in or dropped by on or before your monthly due date. Starting Sept 1st, there will be a late fee imposed on late lot rental payments. Every lot rental paid gives you the authority to park your camper on that site until the due date the next month.
- Music: Music need to be contained by your site and/or cabin. Your music is too loud if it

is heard by your neighbor. We do not allow music with foul language by the Pool or Rec Hall. Outside Music should be turned off by 11pm.

- **Pool:** All children under 12 need to be accompanied by a swimming adult. Please see schedule and rules posted by the pool entrance. No jumping or diving. See bulletin board to find out if there is a designated Adult Hour or Teen Swim. Please clean up trash and belongings after using pool. No glass or pets allowed in pool area.
- Quiet Hours: 11pm -8am. All children should be back at your site or cabin by 10pm.
- Office Hours: 10-4 Monday Saturday, Sunday 10-1 unless posted on the board outside Rec Hall. For emergencies: Debbie 352-454-9353
- **Rec Hall:** All children need to be accompanied by adult after 5pm. Closed at 9pm.
- **RV and Vehicle Parking:** Because of pipes running under the sites, please park only on the allocated lime rock site area. If you are buddy parking, please clear it with the office so you know where not to park to avoid cracking water pipes. This also applies to vehicles, boats and trailers.
- **Security:** Gates are closed from 5pm to 8am. Please close gates when arriving or departing during those hours. Only registered guests are allowed in park during those hours.
- **Smoking:** Smoking is not allowed in the Rec Hall, Bathrooms or Cabins. Smoking at the pool area is allowed if it is not affecting other guests. Please put all ashes and butts in the cans located in the pool area.
- **Speed Limit:** Because of children, please drive 5 MPH in the park. Please do not drive across sites or off the roads (because of water pipes).
- **Stealing:** Anyone who is caught stealing from the park or our guests or intentionally damaging others property will result in their entire group being asked to leave without a refund.
- **Sublet for Snobirds:** No sublets allowed. This campground is privately owned and is not responsible for accidents or deaths and has the right to turn away business.
