

Springs by Lake In the Forest Resort

1) Silver Springs SP(20 minutes west on 40)No swimming but best Kayaking and glass bottom boats. Can do short trip 1 ½ miles total or round trip or 5 ½ miles to Rays Wayside) -pick up on other end needed..

2) Juniper Springs Recreation Area/NF(20 minutes east/40)enclosed spring, walking trails along spring, intermediate-advanced kayak trip.Need pick up on other end.352-625-3147

3) Silver Glen Recreation Area/NF(20 minutes east/40 and then north on 19) Wonderful swimming and picnicing. Great Kayaking but no trailers allowed.352-685-2799

4) Salt Springs Recreation Area/NF(20 minutes east/40 and then north of 19 into Salt Spring. Wonderful swimming area and kayaking. 352-685-2048 If you are only going to Kayak and you are bringing your own, you can also go to Salt Spring Marina(south on 19 from Salt Springs entrance) \$

5) Alexander Springs Recreation Area/NF-east on 40 to 19 and then south to access road. 30 minutes from camp. Not clearly marked. Big

swimming area with picnicing area, hiking trails and kayaking. 352-669-3522 Pasley bike trail is across from entrance.

More SPRINGS:

6)De Leon Springs SP-Deland (45 minutes) swimming, hiking, boat trip, kayak route and famous Pancake House. 501 Ponce Deleon Blvd DeLeon Springs, Florida 32130

7)Rainbow Springs SP-60 minutes west on 40 to 41 south. Tubing, swimming and Kayaking.

8-10)Kelly Rock Springs, Blue Springs, Wekiva Springs -all @ 1 hour

Costs-They may change higher or lower.

(SP) State parks charge \$2pp or per car \$6-8)

(NF)Ocala National Forest Springs(Juniper Springs, Salt Springs, Silver Glen and Alexander Springs) charge @\$14.50 a person over 6 years.

Age 5 and under are free. As of now, the Concession running these Springs may offer 50% off for 1 person with America the Beautiful Senior pass or Handicap Access Pass..

They offer the Hopper Annual pass for \$80.
